The gates can be identified by the I95 exit numbers.

The main gate is at Exit 150A.

The back gate and VCC (<u>Visitor Control Center Open 0600-</u> 1500) is at Exit 148.

- For the Back Gate turn East.

- For the VCC turn West towards the FBI Academy and TBS. The Back Gate is open 0500-2130

One thing is that each person checking in at the VCC must have filled out the <u>NAVMC Form 5512</u>

The base website is = <u>www.quantico.marines.mil</u>

The detail info is found in the drop-down **Base Access**.

That has a lot of info about base access.

I will go to the VCC and talk with the SNCOIC about the way we should do this.

To check in and get thru the gates one must have a government ID card, a CAC card (CAC Card is a <u>Common Access Card</u> which is for qualifying Civilian Employees, Contractors and Foreign National Affiliates who need access to DoD installations) or a driver's license with a Real ID. If they do not have this, they must go thru the Visitor Control Center (VCC) which is off Exit 148 from I95.

The **Front Gate** is open 24 hours a day.

We plan to have a roster of attendees presented to Major Overton (Base Training Command) which he will provide to the base for our event. Still, those without the proper ID will have to check-in at the VCC where they will get a pass for the week that we're there.

This pass will have their info plus a photo, so I'm told.

For those arriving after 1500 we will have to meet them and take them to the Inn via our POV.

IDs:

The form NAVMC 5512 also has a list of acceptable IDs.

That form can be found in the Base Access drop-down.

It would be good for attendees that have to go thru the VCC to print this off and fill it out before arriving.
